A motion was made by Mr. Temple seconded by Mr. Shirley to approve an agreement with Archon Information Services, L.L.C. for professional services in the handling of all properties adjudicated to the police jury and authorizing the president to sign the agreement. Motion carried.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Concordia Parish Police Jury in regular session convened does hereby authorize its president, Melvin Ferrington to enter into the Cooperative Endeavor Agreement for FP & C Project No. 50-J15-14-01 for this much needed project;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the President of the Concordia Parish Police Jury, Melvin Ferrington, is hereby authorized to sign any and all documents pertaining to this project, including certifying requests for State reimbursements, needed to effectuate this agreement.
