The Police Jury of Concordia Parish met this day in regular session convened. There were present the following members:

President:	Collin Edwards
Members:	Joseph Parker, Sr., Willie Yearby, Gary Neal, Adam Probst, Genesis Allen, Brad Adams
Absent:	Maurice Bachus, Scottie Whittington
Secretary Treasurer:	Sandi T. Burley
Invocation:	Mr. Yearby
Pledge of Allegiance:	Mr. Probst

- 1) The meeting was called to order by Mr. Edwards. Ms. Burley conducted the roll call and a quorum was declared present.
- 2) A motion was made by Mr. Probst seconded by Mr. Yearby to approve the minutes of the April 11, 2022 meeting as distributed. Motion carried unanimously.
- 3) A request to fill the board vacancy of Mr. Jerry Stalling for the Concordia airport Authority was received. The Board recommended the appointment of Mr. Martin Hammett to the Board. A motion was made by Mr. Neal seconded by Mr. Adams to approve the appointment. Motion carried unanimously.
- 4) A request from USACE was received to accept the work on Maxwell Road as satisfactorily complete and returned to the Parish. Both Mr. Edwards and Mr. Parker had reviewed the work conducted. A motion was made by Mr. Parker seconded by Mr. Parker to allow the President to sign the acceptance letter with USACE. Motion carried unanimously.
- 5) Committee Reports were next:
Grants Committee: The Grants Committee met and reviewed the ARPA Guidelines and request for fund allocations. Resolution 22-011 for ARPA Funding Allocations was offered to amend the resolution passed in 2021. A motion was made by Mr. Neal seconded by Mr. Yearby to approve the resolution. There were no comments and the motion carried unanimously.

6) Projects of the Parish were next discussed:

Brushy Bayou – DOTD has returned the preliminary drawings to JKS for additional corrections needed.

PA 4462 – The gravel portion of the project is approved. The asphalt road portion is under review to be awarded.

Broadband – No further updates have been announced on GUMBO or RDOF funding.

ARPA – No further updates were needed. A request was received from the Monterey Rural Water System for use of the funding allocations toward softening resin. Three quotes were obtained to support the procurement requirement. The lowest quote was for Resin Tech softening resin for \$84,6000.45 (with additional \$1500 for taxes and freight). A motion was made by Mr. Neal seconded by Mr. Probst to approve the disbursement of the ARPA funds toward the purchase. Motion carried unanimously.

HM-CPPJ 2022 (Vidalia Canal Study) – The Waterways Committee (Parker, Yearby, Neal) had met to review the RFQ for Engineering to conduct a study and design of the Vidalia Canal at Cocodrie Bayou toward mitigation efforts. Two proposals were received: Jordan, Kaiser & Sessions (JKS) and Bryant Hammett and Associates (BHA). During the scoring and reviewing process by the committee, JKS was deemed non-responsive as their proposal did not include all the required documents. A motion was made by Mr. Parker seconded by Mr. Yearby to award the RFQ to BHA as the responsive proposer. There were no further comments and motion carried unanimously.

7) Under Ordinance Violations, Mr. Parker brought forward the issue of dumping in the parish specifically on Bayou and Lower Levee Roads. Discussion was held to put the surveillance cameras back in place to monitor illegal dumping in the parish.

8) Under the Secretary / Treasurer's Report, Ms. Burley brought forward:

A. Tier 3 Reports are due by May 15th.

B. Bill Blair will be conducting a mapping meeting on April 28 and 29th. The meeting on the 28th is scheduled to begin at 10:30 with a review of the current preliminary maps. This meeting is a joint meeting between CPPJ and CPSB.

C. LGAP projects for requested funding is due June 3rd. Ms. Burley asked Mr. Guillory to work on a list of requests for the upcoming funding application.

9) A motion was made by Mr. Adams seconded by Mr. Yearby and carried unanimously to approve the following occupational licenses:

- Cenla Pregnancy Center dba Miss Lou Pregnancy Center, 4951 Hwy 84, Vidalia
- Swampyard Enterprise, Edward Jefferson, 255 Mimosa Drive – record/movie/film company; apparel and shoes
- Carolyn's Interior Design, Carolyn Powell, 255 Mimosa Drive – interior decorating
- Boggy Bayou Processors, LLC, 603 Boggy Bayou Road – meat processing

- 10) Mr. Guillory gave the following updates on Superintendent's Work Orders.
610 (yards) – 5 BJ Road; 5 Sage Road; 20 Eagle Road; 10 East Road; 5 Belle Grove; 15 National Guard Road; 30 Country Meadows; 30 Bodark Road
Maintenance Gravel (yards) – 15 Monterey Dump Site; 45 Bodark; 30 Southwind; 15 Poole Road Ferriday
Culverts approved at last meeting should arrive on Thursday.
A motion was made by Mr. Adams seconded by Mr. Parker to approve the work orders.
- 11) Work Orders from the Jurors were next brought forward. A motion was made by Mr. Yearby seconded by Mr. Parker to approve the following:
Yearby – limbs on Concordia Park and Freeman Road
Alien – raw sewage complaints in canal near Delta Charter (discussing with Caleb Smith, Sanitarian)
Guillory – discussed the need for 3 large culverts on Bob Rife and Emfinger Road. Quotes have been obtained and the cost will be \$29,495. Mr. Guillory stated these 12 gause culverts have approximately a 25 year life span.
Motion carried unanimously.
- 12) Under Correspondence, Mr. Adams discussed security cameras needed at the maintenance unit as discussed at a prior meeting. A cost of approximately \$85 each for 3 cameras using solar power and wifi capabilities was obtained. A motion was made by Mr. Neal, seconded by Mr. Yearby and carried unanimously to purchase the security cameras.
- 13) No Executive Session was needed.
- 14) A motion was made by Mr. Neal seconded by Ms. Allen to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.

RESOLUTION 22-011

A RESOLUTION COMMITTING FUNDS FROM THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT (ARPA) AND FURTHER PROVIDING OTHER DETAILS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH

WHEREAS, the ARPA fund allocations have been previously allocated under Resolution 21-014 to Lake St. John Waterworks, Monterey Rural Water System, Concordia Waterworks, and Concordia Parish Sewer District operate a public water or sewerage system serving residents of the unincorporated portions of Concordia Parish in which to make applications to the State of Louisiana's "Water Sector Program", Drinking Water Revolving Loan Fund Louisiana Community Development Block Grant programs and/or internal utility projects to make improvements to water/sewerage treatments and/or production system improvements;

WHEREAS, the Parish is in need of projects and improvements available under ARPA provisions to provide support to the residents of the unincorporated portions of Concordia Parish;

WHEREAS, the Concordia Parish Police Jury has received funds from the United States through the American Rescue Plan Act ("ARPA") that may be used for the "Government Services to the Extent of Revenue Loss", "Investments in Broadband Infrastructure", and/or "Capital Expenditures";

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED that the Concordia Parish Police Jury does hereby continue to allocate and commit funds of the Concordia Parish Police Jury's ARPA funds to serve as matching funds, exclusive of funds needed for Administration and Engineering unless properly procured, for the Lake St. John Waterworks, Monterey Rural Water System, Concordia Waterworks, and Concordia Parish Sewer District applications to the Water Sector Program, Drinking Water Revolving Loan Fund, and/or Louisiana Community Development Block Grant programs for grant funding to provide water/sewerage treatment and production system improvements;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Concordia Parish Police Jury makes the following amended allocations to Revenue Replacement, Broadband, and/or Capital Expenditures under the provisions to ARPA as:

The funds approved for Sewer / Water Allocations are:

Lake St. John Water Works - \$150,000

Monterey Rural Water System - \$300,000

Concordia Water Works District No 1 - \$300,000

Concordia Parish Sewage District No 1 - \$400,000

Other Allocations (cost estimates):

Broadband - \$200,000 (if the water/sewer systems do not have a cost overrun)

Capital Expenditures for Drainage Projects - \$250,000

Administration of Parish Other Allocation Projects - \$75,000

Parish Operating Funds (General, Highway, Drainage, etc.) - \$2,065,000 (if other allocations do not have a cost overrun)

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the President of the Concordia Parish Police Jury is hereby authorized to execute a Cooperative Endeavor Agreement and distribution of funds to the water and sewer districts aforementioned;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Concordia Parish Police Jury has determined capital expenditures to be less than \$1 million or more and written justification requirements are not applicable under the SLFRF (ARPA) guidelines. Appropriate reporting will be submitted.

ORDINANCE NO: 2022-04

An Ordinance to establish divided precincts, provide for polling locations and to adopt a redistricting plan for the Concordia Parish Police Jury; and otherwise, to provide with respect thereto.

WHEREAS, the Concordia Parish Police Jury is elected from multi-member and single member districts;

WHEREAS, interposing the population data from the 2020 federal decennial census into the current districting plan for the Concordia Parish Police Jury discloses that there are districts which exceed the acceptable population deviation under the principal of one-person-one-vote;

WHEREAS, Louisiana law requires the Concordia Parish Police Jury to declare whether its existing districting plan is malapportioned following a federal decennial census; and if so, provide for a new redistricting plan;

WHEREAS, the Concordia Parish Police Jury, is unable to create a redistricting plan using the whole precincts submitted to the United States Bureau of the Census and, in accordance with LRS 18:532.1(D)(2), will need to divide several precincts into two or more precincts, which divisions shall be by a visible feature which is a census tabulation boundary.

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CONCORDIA PARISH POLICE JURY THAT:

SECTION 1

- A. The Concordia Parish Police Jury hereby divides and creates new precincts to be used in its redistricting plan to be first implemented for all purposes related to the qualifying for elections and the regularly scheduled elections for Concordia Parish in the Fall of 2022.
- B. The geographic precinct divisions are described below and more specifically depicted and clarified in the maps, shapefiles and block equivalency files submitted to the Louisiana Secretary of State for their implementation.
- C. The precincts listed in Part C are described specifically in Part D1 through Part D6.

Precinct 4-4 is hereby divided to create Precinct 4-4 and Precinct 1-2A
Precinct 4-2 is hereby divided to create Precinct 4-2 and Precinct 1-3A
Precinct 5-1 is hereby divided to create Precinct 5-1 and Precinct 4-2A
Precinct 5-3 is hereby divided to create Precinct 5-3 and Precinct 5-4A
Precinct 3-2 is hereby divided to create Precinct 3-2 and Precinct 2-1A
Precinct 3-1 is hereby divided to create Precinct 3-1 and Precinct 2-1B
Precinct 5-2B is hereby renamed into Precinct 4-2B

D1. Precinct 4-4 is hereby divided to create Precinct 4-4 and Precinct 1-2A

Polling Location: Precincts 4-4 and 1-2A shall have a consolidated polling location at the current polling location of Precinct 4-4.

Precinct 1-2A

Beginning at the intersection of Kentucky Ave and N 2nd St, then south on 2nd St to its intersection with Virginia Ave, then west on Virginia Ave to its intersection with N 3rd St, then north on N 3rd St to its intersection with Kentucky Ave, then east on Kentucky Ave to the point of beginning.

Precinct 4-4

Precinct 4-4 shall be the prior Precinct 4-4, less and except Precinct 1-2A as herein described.

D2. Precinct 4-2 is hereby divided to create Precinct 4-2 and Precinct 1-3A

Polling Location: Precincts 4-2 and 1-3A shall have a consolidated polling location at the current polling location of Precinct 4-2.

Precinct 1-3A

Beginning at the intersection of Bayou Cocodrie and Lake Concordia, then east and southeast following the centerline of Lake Concordia and its extension to its intersection with State Route 3196, then south on State Route 3196 to its intersection with Fisherman Dr, then west on Fisherman Dr to its intersection with Bayou Cocodrie, then east on the bayou to the point of beginning.

Precinct 4-2

Precinct 4-2 shall be the prior Precinct 4-2, less and except Precinct 1-3A as herein described.

D3. Precinct 5-1 is hereby divided to create Precinct 5-1 and Precinct 4-2A

Polling Location: Precincts 5-1 and 4-2A shall have a consolidated polling location at the current polling location of Precinct 5-1.

Precinct 4-2A

Beginning at the intersection of Louisiana Ave and a powerline 375 feet east of Persimmon Mill Rd, then north on the powerline to its intersection with Black Bayou, then east on Black Bayou to its intersection with a tributary of Black Bayou located at (-91.584466, 31.626568), then east along the tributary to its intersection with Louisiana Ave, then southwest on Louisiana Ave to the point of beginning.

Precinct 5-1

Precinct 5-1 shall be the prior Precinct 5-1, less and except Precinct 4-2A as herein described.

D4. Precinct 5-3 is hereby divided to create Precinct 5-3 and Precinct 5-4A

Polling Location: Precincts 5-3 and 5-4A shall have a consolidated polling location at the current polling location of Precinct 5-3.

Precinct 5-4A

Beginning at the intersection of Hwy 600 and Bodark Rd, then east on Bodark Rd to its intersection with Deadening Rd, then northeast on Deadening Rd to its intersection with Kenyon Bayou, then east on the bayou to its intersection with the shoreline of Horseshoe Lake, then north along the shoreline to its intersection with a canal located at (-91.732707, 31.508694), then north along the canal to its intersection with Hwy 565, then west on the highway to its intersection with Hwy 600, then south on Hwy 600 to the point of beginning.

Precinct 5-3

Precinct 5-3 shall be the prior Precinct 5-3, less and except Precinct 5-4A as herein described.

D5. Precinct 3-2 is hereby divided to create Precinct 3-2 and Precinct 2-1A

Polling Location: Precincts 3-2 and 2-1A shall have a consolidated polling location at the current polling location of Precinct 3-2.

Precinct 2-1A

Beginning at the intersection of Hwy 65 and Cedar St, then south on Cedar St to its intersection with John Dale Dr, then northwest on John Dale Dr to its intersection with Mathews St, then north on Mathews St to its intersection with Hwy 65, then east on Hwy 65 to the point of beginning.

Precinct 3-2

Precinct 3-2 shall be the prior Precinct 3-2, less and except Precinct 2-1A as herein described.

D6. Precinct 3-1 is hereby divided to create Precinct 3-1 and Precinct 2-1B

Polling Location: Precincts 3-1 and 2-1B shall have a consolidated polling location at the current polling location of Precinct 3-1.

Precinct 2-1B

Beginning at the intersection of N Oak St and Concordia Ave, then north on Concordia Ave to its intersection with Stampley St, then northeast on Stampley St to its intersection with Alabama St, then north on Alabama St to its intersection with Locust St, then northeast on Locust St to its intersection with Milligan St, the south on Milligan St to its intersection with N Oak St, then southwest on N Oak St to the point of beginning.

Precinct 3-1

Precinct 3-1 shall be the prior Precinct 3-1, less and except Precinct 2-1B as herein described.

D7. Precinct 5-2B is hereby renamed into Precinct 4-2B

Polling Location: Precinct 4-2B shall maintain the current polling location as former Precinct 5-2B.

SECTION 2

- A. The redistricting plan entitled Concordia PJ-SB Plan 2022, as described below and specifically depicted and clarified on maps, electronic shapefiles and block equivalency files submitted to the Louisiana Secretary of State, be and is hereby adopted and such plan shall be utilized for qualifying for elections in the Fall of 2022 and the regularly scheduled elections in the Fall of 2022 for Concordia Parish, in accordance with Louisiana law.
- B. The Concordia Parish Police Jury shall be comprised of nine (9) Police Jurors with residency requirements within each multi-member district:

Two (2) shall be elected from District 1 designated as 1A and 1B
One (1) shall be elected from District 2
Two (2) shall be elected from District 3 designated as 3A and 3B
Two (2) shall be elected from District 4 designated as 4A and 4B
One (1) shall be elected from District 5A
One (1) shall be elected from District 5B

C1. DISTRICT 1

District 1 shall consist of Precincts 1-1, 1-2, 1-2A, 1-2B, 1-3 and 1-4

District 1A shall have a residency requirement to qualify for election from:

Precincts 1-1, 1-2, 1-2A and 1-2B

District 1B shall have a residency requirement to qualify for election from:

Precincts 1-3, 1-4

C2. DISTRICT 2

District 2 shall consist of Precincts 2-1, 2-1A and 2-1B

C3. DISTRICT 3

District 3 shall consist of Precincts 3-1, 3-2, 3-3 and 3-4

District 3A shall have a residency requirement to qualify for election from:

Precincts 3-1 and 3-2

District 3B shall have a residency requirement to qualify for election from:

Precincts 3-3 and 3-4

C4. DISTRICT 4

District 4 shall consist of Precincts 4-1, 4-2, 4-2A, 4-2B, 4-3 and 4-4

District 4A shall have a residency requirement to qualify for election from:

Precincts 4-3 and 4-4

District 4B shall have a residency requirement to qualify for election from:

Precincts 4-1, 4-2, 4-2A and 4-2B

C5. DISTRICT 5A

District 5A shall consist of Precincts 5-1, 5-2, 5-4 and 5-4A

C6. DISTRICT 5B

District 5B shall consist of Precincts 5-3, 5-5 and 5-6

WHEREAS, the Lake St. John Waterworks will continue to use the funds to replace the remaining 280 meters needed to upgrade equipment to aid in the relief of repair costs and expedited monitoring of any issues to water lines;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Concordia Parish Police Jury did in regular session convened does hereby request funding through a CWF 2021-2022 grant to fund the purchase of this much needed equipment;
