The meeting was called to order by Mr. Edwards. Mrs. Carter conducted the roll and a Quorum was declared present.

Upon a motion by Mr. Probst, duly seconded by Mr. Adams to approve the minutes of the January 23, 2023, regular meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Under Project/Grant Updates Interim Secretary/Treasurer Cathy Darden provided the following updates: FEMA paved roads extensions have been granted. Mrs. Darden and Mrs. Carter received notice that the Parish is eligible for a 256K grant in which will be applied for. Mr. Lee with Capital Outlay would not allow is to declare the chiller an emergency. Mrs. Darden is in the process of looking for a mechanical engineer to begin on the chiller project. Mrs. Darden is going to check with Rostan on the next step for Brushy Bayou.
