The Concordia Parish Police Jury met this day in regular session convened. There were present the following members:

The meeting was called to order by President Lewis Ms. Carter conducted the roll and a Quorum was declared present.

Upon a motion by Mr. Probst, duly seconded by Mr. Washington to approve the minutes from the November 10, 2025 regular meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Washington, duly seconded by Mr. Probst to enter the public hearing on adopting an ordinance to merge voting precincts 1-1 and 1-2. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Washington, duly seconded by Mrs. Allen to exit the public hearing. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Washington, duly seconded by Mr. Probst to adopt an ordinance on merging voting precincts 1-1 and 1-2. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Probst, duly seconded by Mr. Edwards to approve to advertise for a public hearing on adopting an ordinance on the merging of voting precincts 1-1 and 1-2 which will move voters from the Ferriday City Hall to the Ferriday Health Unit. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mrs. Allen, duly seconded by Mr. Probst to approve the alcohol permit for U Save # 2 in Ferriday, La. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mrs. Allen, duly seconded by Mr. Washington to award the Chiller Replacement Project to Mechanical Cooling Services in the amount of \$333,000.00. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mrs. Allen, duly seconded by Mr. Washington to reappoint Mrs. Kathleen Stevens to another 5-year term on the Concordia Parish Library Board. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Washington, duly seconded by Mr. Probst to replace Mr. Jackie Johnston with Mrs. Elizabeth Smith to the Recreation District #3 Board. Mr. Kale Davis abstained from voting. Motion carried.

The following updates were provided for Superintendent's Work Orders:

Pitrun (yards) – 60 yds on Como and 60 yds on Bee Brake
Washrock (yards) – 20yds on Mallet Rd.

Mrs. Allen advised the Jury that she spoke with Ms. King and after checking law, they can now offer optional health insurance to the jurors.


Mr. Lewis advised that he would like to send a letter of interest to LITACorp.
