REGULAR MEETING
JANUARY 22, 2024

The Concordia Parish Police Jury met this day in regular session convened. There were present the following members:

The meeting was called to order by Mr. Collin Edwards. Mrs. Carter conducted the roll and a Quorum was declared present.

Upon a motion by Mr. Bachus, duly seconded by Mr. Probst to approve the minutes from the January 8, 2024, regular meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Probst, duly seconded by Mr. Tiffie to approve the following material bid awardees:

- C&M Earthworks, LLC- Clay Gravel/Pitrun
- APAC Mississippi – Washed Maintenance Gravel, washed oversize rock, and sand
- Terral Riverservice – Crushed limestone
- Scott Petroleum – Fuel and Lubrication fluids
- Helena Agri-Enterprises – Chemicals

Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Tiffie, duly seconded by Mr. Probst to update the number of residents for garbage pickup from 4,300 to 5,084. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Tiffie, duly seconded by Mr. Lewis to approve the purchase of a motor grader using ACT 397 funds in the amount of \$100,000.00 with the jury paying the difference. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Lewis, duly seconded by Mr. Davis to approve the repairs for the hall elevator due to recent water damage. Motion carried unanimously.

Work Orders from the Jurors were next brought forward. A motion was made by Mr. Probst, duly seconded by Mr. Tiffie to approve the following:

Mr. Lewis – BJ Road, Sage Road, the first half of Stephens Road, and Guido Road need culverts checked for replacement.

Mr. Tiffie- Poole Road in Monterey needs to be patched, DOTD needs a letter asking for assistance with Bogy Bayou Rd., check on Bogy Bayou bridge, Wild Cow Road needs gravel, and BB Beard Road needs a turnaround for the trash truck.

The following updates were provided for Superintendent's Work Orders:
610 (yards) – 32 yds on Pete Cross and 30 yds on Haphazard Road
Maintenance Gravel (yards) – 45yds on Bodark.

A motion was made by Mr. Probst, duly seconded by Mr. Davis to approve the material list. Motion carried unanimously.

Committee Meetings were next on the agenda, members of the Personnel Committee met on 1/19/2024 and discussed bringing back former Maintenance Superintendent Mr. Jackie Pugh as a part-time employee to help out the maintenance barn.

Upon a motion by Mr. Tiffie, duly seconded by Mr. Lewis to approve hiring Mr. Pugh as a part-time employee. Motion carried unanimously.


Under new business, the following was brought forward by Mr. Simpson. Mr. Simpson asked that Mrs. Carter get an updated list of all board members from the parish boards such as the rec board, hospital, sewer and water, along with copies of their minutes.

Upon a motion by Mr. Washington, duly seconded by Mr. Simpson to have Mrs. Carter reach out to the respective boards requesting the above information. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Probst, duly seconded by Mr. Tiffie to adjourn Motion carried unanimously.
