The Concordia Parish Police Jury met this day in regular session convened. There were present the following members:

The meeting was called to order by President Edwards. Mrs. Carter conducted the roll and a Quorum was declared present.

Upon a motion by Mr. Probst, duly seconded by Mr. Tiffie to approve the minutes from the May 13, 2024, regular meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Probst, duly seconded by Mr. Simpson to excuse the absence of Mrs. Genesis Allen from the May 13, 2024 regular meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Probst, duly seconded by Mr. Davis to approve the following hold harmless requests, motion carried unanimously.

- Assist with cutting the grass on the field adjacent to Vidalia Junior High
- Assist with cleaning the culverts at Concordia Education Center on Kindergarten Rd.

Mr. Lewis – 393 Terry Circle, 299 Terry Circle, 120 Ashley Lane, need limbs picked up. 141 BJ Road needs debris that the maintenance unit from cleaning the ditches out. Along side Moose Lodge Road coming back East needs drainage checked or dug out by Forrest Road and Audubon Acres.

Mr. Edwards for Mr. Washington – pile of pecan limbs on Vernon Road need to be picked up.

Mr. Tiffie – Pot holes on Poole Road in Monterey need to be filled.
