

**CONCORDIA PARISH POLICE JURY
REGULAR MEETING**

The Concordia Parish Police Jury met this day in regular session convened. There were present the following members:

The meeting was called to order by President Lewis Ms. Carter conducted the roll and a Quorum was declared present.

Upon a motion by Mr. Probst, duly seconded by Mr. Simpson to approve the minutes from the May 27, 2025 regular meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Probst, duly seconded by Mr. Washington to approve purchase orders, statutory reports, bank statements, and bank reconciliations as reported. Motion carried unanimously.

Next up Ms. Susan Johnston addressed the jury stating that flooding is a major issue in the Parish especially on Moose Lodge, Sage, Stephens, and BJ Roads. Ms. Johnston went on to state that four times in the past eight weeks they have had over a foot of water in their yards. Ms. Johnson suggested that the ditches be cleaned out to alleviate the flooding.

Upon a motion from Mrs. Allen, duly seconded by Mr. Probst to adopt a revised ordinance to authorize an act of sale by the Parish of Concordia to sell certain adjudicated properties by public auction; and, further providing with respect thereto. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mrs. Allen, duly seconded by Mr. Edwards to adopt a resolution to authorize the President to execute any and all ACT 776 documents. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Tiffie, duly seconded by Mr. Probst to adopt a resolution authorizing the President to execute any and all documents for the sale of surplus property. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Probst, duly seconded by Mr. Washington to approve the following alcohol beverage permits. Motion carried unanimously.
