REGULAR MEETING**

**JUNE 24, 2024

The Concordia Parish Police Jury met this day in regular session convened. There were present the following members:

The meeting was called to order by Vice President Probst. Mrs. Carter conducted the roll and a Quorum was declared present.

Upon a motion by Mrs. Allen, duly seconded by Mr. Tiffie to approve the minutes from the June 10, 2024, regular meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Tiffie, duly seconded by Mrs. Allen to approve to advertise for the bids for the Black Lake Lease Tract I (Water Portion) and Track II (Land Portion). Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Washington, duly seconded by Mr. Lewis to approve a letter of support for the United Hands Youth Center (Doty Road Center) to secure a grant to purchase three new air units for their building. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Probst, duly seconded by Mr. Simpson to cite the following ordinance violations. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Lewis, duly seconded by Mr. Washington to have the Maintenance Unit look at houses that have had ordinance violation letters sent out to see if they can clean the lots up. Motion carried unanimously.

Work Orders from the Jurors were next brought forward. A motion was made by Mr. Lewis, duly seconded by Mr. Tiffie to approve the following:

Mr. Lewis – 610 needs to be placed on the driveways on East Road.

The following updates were provided for Superintendent's Work Orders:

610 (yards) – 14yds on Shady Acres, 28yds on Eagle, 32yds on McCall, 14yds on Stephens, 64yds on Bodark, 27yds on Belle Grove, 34yds on Townsend, 17yds on Abraham.

Maintenance Gravel (yards) – 5yds on Luneau, 32yds on Evans, 32yds on Emfinger, 64yds on Luke Martin, 16yds on Myers, 32yds on Tanner, 32yds on Plouden Bayou, and 64yds on C-Finley.

A motion was made by Mr. Lewis, duly seconded by Mr. Tiffie to approve the material list and job advertisement. Motion carried unanimously.

Under new business the following was brought forward:

Upon a motion by Mr. Lewis, duly seconded by Mr. Tiffie to approve the occupational license for Cross Creations (Margie Bolyer). Motion carried unanimously.


