The Concordia Parish Police Jury met this day in regular session convened. There were present the following members:

The meeting was called to order by Mr. Edwards. Mrs. Carter conducted the roll and a Quorum was declared present.

Upon a motion by Mr. Adams, duly seconded by Mr. Neal to approve the minutes from of the June 12, 2023, regular meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Neal, duly seconded by Mr. Whittington to reappoint Mr. Carl Sayers to serve a three-year period as a member of the Concordia Parish Airport Authority. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Parker, duly seconded by Mr. Bachus to authorize the President to execute the Brushy Bayou Drainage Project Contract. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Whittington, duly seconded by Mr. Bachus to announce the awardee for the courthouse painting bid to Premier One Painting, LLC. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Parker, duly seconded by Mrs. Allen to approve Trane to replace the condenser coils in the jail in the amount of \$7,458.00. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mrs. Allen, duly seconded by Mr. Neal to approve the following Alcohol Beverage Permits:

- Gurpreet Singh dba Marina Fuel in Monterey, LA
- Fred Taylor dba Illusions, LLC in Vidalia, LA. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Bachus, duly seconded by Mr. Whittington to approve the Secretary/Treasurer and the Bookkeeper to attend the OPAO Convention July 26-28, 2023 in Bossier City, LA.

Work orders from the Jurors were next brought forward. A motion was made by Mr. Parker, duly seconded by Mr. Whittington to approve the following:

Mr. Parker – District needs a limb pick up run. Ditches near the old pallet plant and Bayou Drive need to be cleaned up.

Mr. Whittington – Dich on BB Rd. by the fence needs to be cleaned up. 5 ton weight limit signs need to be put on assigned streets.

Mrs. Allen – T's Road needs a street sign put up.

Mr. Neal – Send letter to DOTD chase unit to look at three culverts coming into Ferriday by Cocodrie Bayou.

Mr. Adams – 181 Perchhole Bayou Road needs the driveway fixed.

The following updates were provided for Superintendent's Work Orders:

Maintenance Gravel – 48yds on Temple Rd.

FEMA Stockpile – 48 yds of 610, 484 yards of Maintenance Gravel, and 176 yards of Pitrun.


