The Concordia Parish Police Jury met this day in regular session convened. There were present the following members:

The meeting was called to order by President Lewis Ms. Carter conducted the roll and a Quorum was declared present.

Upon a motion by Mr. Probst, duly seconded by Mr. Simpson to approve the minutes from the June 9, 2025 regular meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion from Mr. Probst, duly seconded by Mr. Edwards to approve the absence of Mr. Maurice Bachus and Mr. Kale Davis from the June 9, 2025 regular meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Simpson, duly seconded by Mr. Probst to approve a hold harmless to assist the Vidalia Cemetery with removing the stumps and debris from the cemetery grounds. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mrs. Allen, duly seconded by Mr. Probst to adopt the amended 2025 budget. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mrs. Allen, duly seconded by Mr. Davis to approve advertising any/all vacant positions that may become available. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Bachus, duly seconded by Mr. Probst to table the appointment of Mr. Justin Connor to serve a three-year term on the Board of Directors for the Central Louisiana Human Services District. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Bachus, duly seconded by Mr. Davis to cite the following ordinance violations. Motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Bachus – Between 155 and 179 Bayou Drive needs to be cleaned up. 149 Skipper, 160 Skipper, behind 152 Skipper cleanup. 10th street needs spraying. Next to 347 Florence Matthews cleanup.

Mr. Washington – 161 Skipper (cleanup), Lot next to 161 Skipper has been adjudicated and can be cleaned up by the parish.

Mr. Simpson – 443 Freeman Road (grass)

A motion was made by Mr. Probst, duly seconded by Mrs. Allen to approve superintendent's work orders. Motion carried unanimously.

New Business:

Mr. Lewis requested that we advertise for bids to have a few trees cut from Sage, Mooselodge, and Roundtree.


