The Concordia Parish Police Jury met this day in regular session convened. There were present the following members:

The meeting was called to order by Mr. Edwards. Mrs. Carter conducted the roll and a Quorum was declared present.

Upon a motion by Mr. Probst, duly seconded by Mr. Neal to approve the minutes from of the July 10, 2023, regular meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Parker, duly seconded by Mr. Bachus to waive the absence of Genesis Allen from the July 10, 2023 regular meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

The coroner Dr. Dennis Laravia addressed the jury and gave an overview and summary of the last 40 months of coroner activities.

Upon a motion by Mr. Neal, duly seconded by Mrs. Allen to approve a resolution obligating a 25% match to Capital Outlay to reconstruct the Parish's portion of Doty Road/903. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Probst, duly seconded by Mr. Adams to authorize the President to execute the revised contract for Brushy Bayou Project Contract. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Adams, duly seconded by Mr. Neal to approve the occupational license for Mark Anthony Carney dba Black River Grill, LLC. Motion carried unanimously.

Work Orders from the Jurors were next brought forward. A motion was made by Mr. Probst, duly seconded by Mr. Adams to approve the following:

Mr. Bachus – Cutting needs to be done in Ferriday, and the limb truck needs to make rounds.

Mr. Parker – Asked the status of the limb truck, and advised that limbs are down over the parish.

Mrs. Allen – The end of Serio Blvd needs hot mix.

Mr. Neal – U.S. Hwy 84 across from Slicks has limbs on Westbound side that need to be picked up.

Upon a motion by Mr. Parker, duly seconded by Mrs. Allen to run an ad in the paper to receive bids on an aquaculture contract to spray Cocodrie Bayou. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mrs. Allen, duly seconded by Mr. Neal to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried unanimously.
