The Concordia Parish Police Jury met this day in regular session convened. There were present the following members:

The meeting was called to order by President Lewis Ms. Carter conducted the roll and a Quorum was declared present.

Upon a motion by Mrs. Allen, duly seconded by Mr. Probst to approve the minutes from the August 25, 2025 regular meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Washington, duly seconded by Mr. Simpson to approve the absence of Mr. Mr. Red Tiffie from the August 25, 2025 regular meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Washington, duly seconded by Mr. Probst to approve the purchase orders, statutory reports, bank statements, and bank reconciliations as reported. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Probst, duly seconded by Mr. Tiffie to certify the 2025 tax roll. Motion carried unanimously.

Next up Mrs. Ana-Alicia Gouge with the LSU AgCenter addressed the Jury with updates on 4-H this summer. Eleven youth from Concordia Parish represented the Parish with pride and excellence. Mrs. Gouge stated that these kids deserve a "pat on the back". Mrs. Gouge also stated that there has been a good turnout with the kids and made mention of meetings being underway. Ms. Kylie Miller advised that they are in the process of hiring an irrigation specialist/weed scientist. She also added that beef cattle field day is September 18th, and a crop insurance meeting will be held on November 18th. Ms. Miller went on to advise that corn yields are good, soybean yields are fair, and cotton is off by two weeks.

Upon a motion by Mr. Tiffie, duly seconded by Mr. Probst to approve an occupational license for Old River Nutrition, LLC in Monterey. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Probst, duly seconded by Mr. Washington to cite the following ordinance violations:

Mrs. Allen – on the left and right of 314 Green Acres Road trees are down and lots need to be cleaned.

Mr. Davis – 121 North Grove needs cleaning.

Work Orders from the Jurors were next brought forward. A motion was made by Mr. Probst, duly seconded by Mr. Davis, to approve the following:

Mrs. Allen – Levee Heights new culverts the rocks have washed out causing pot holes; 111 Lee Street has pot holes in street near driveway; 108 Morales grass in ditches; 3232 Tuminello needs ditching they are flooding again and need the beaver dams removed.

Mr. Lewis – Old River Road and Minorca need to be graded.

Mr. Davis – Boom truck needed on Cowan.

Mr. Tiffie – New chip sealer would be beneficial; no road product is needed at this time.

New Business:

Mr. Guillory advised the chip seal guys will let him know how much per mile to have roads done.

Upon a motion by Mrs. Allen, duly seconded by Mr. Probst to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.
