

**CONCORDIA PARISH POLICE JURY
REGULAR MEETING**

**August 11, 2025
6:00 P.M.**

The Concordia Parish Police Jury met this day in regular session convened. There were present the following members:

The meeting was called to order by President Lewis Ms. Carter conducted the roll and a Quorum was declared present.

Upon a motion by Mr. Simpson, duly seconded by Mr. Edwards to approve the minutes from the July 28, 2025 regular meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Edwards, duly seconded by Mr. Davis to approve the absence of Mrs. Genesis Allen from the July 28, 2025 regular meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Washington, duly seconded by Mr. Bachus to approve the purchase orders, statutory reports, bank statements, and bank reconciliations as reported. Motion carried unanimously.

Next Ms. Donna Metz addressed the jury in reference to the noise at Dockrocker's. Ms. Metz understands that an exemption was granted for the Memorial Day and 4th of July weekends until 11p.m, however the noise carried on until 2a.m. Ms. Metz was advised that the Sheriff Department is to enforce the ordinance and issue citations for the noise violations outside of the exemption. Ms. Metz advised that she wishes the owners would build a soundproof wall to alleviate the noise. Mrs. Allen advised to send a letter to Dockrocker's advising them that the exemption was for two events only, and to advise them of the complaints that have been made against them, and to also check with IBTS for sound barriers at Dockrocker's.

Upon a motion by Mrs. Allen, duly seconded by Mr. Edwards to approve the alcohol beverage permit for Gurlove Singh dba Marina Food Mart in Monterey. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Simpson, duly seconded by Mrs. Allen to approve an occupational license for Linda's Kitchen and Snowballs Inc in Vidalia. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mrs. Allen, duly seconded by Mr. Bachus to cite the following ordinance violations:

Mr. Bachus – 161 Skipper Drive – grass and lot cleaned
Mr. Simpson – 548 Concordia Park Drive needs to be cleaned up and 443 Freeman Road grass.
Mr. Lewis – 863 Highway 171 – grass and crown lot.

Work Orders from the Jurors were next brought forward. A motion was made by Mr. Bachus, duly seconded by Mrs. Allen, to approve the following:

Mr. Bachus – spraying and cutting in Ferriday near the water & across the track and 10th and 15th streets need cutting.
Mr. Simpson – Westside & Mooselodge & Howard need reclaim & cold patch.
Mrs. Allen – Delta Charter needs the boom tractor to cut the canal, Abraham Lane needs potholes patched, Netherland & Earl Davis need street signs. Tolliver has a low area and may need to be leveled. Knocker Road deep rut in the road. Black Bayou needs deep curve sign. 393 Townsend needs culvert.
Mr. Lewis – Crack sealer machine is needed on Stephens Road. Airport Road where the gravel starts need pothole patched.
Mr. Davis – Check out ditch on Southside.

The following updates were provided for Superintendent's Work Orders:

610 (yards) – 15yds on Bodark, 34yds on Townsend, 19yds on North Grove, 2yds on Poole Road
Ferriday, 36yds on Levens Addition
Maintenance Gravel – 15yds on Bodark
Culverts – (2) 24” x40’ on North Grove
A motion was made by Mr. Bachus, duly seconded by Mrs. Allen to approve superintendent’s work
orders. Motion carried unanimously.


New Business:
