The Concordia Parish Police Jury met this day in regular session convened. There were present the following members:

The meeting was called to order by Mr. Edwards. Mrs. Carter conducted the roll and a Quorum was declared present.

Upon a motion by Mr. Probst, duly seconded by Mr. Bachus to approve the minutes from of the August 28, 2023, regular meeting, Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Probst, duly seconded by Mr. Bachus to approve purchase orders, statutory reports, bank statements, and bank reconciliations as reported. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Neal, duly seconded by Mrs. Allen to approve to advertise for a public hearing on the senior housing development plans on North Grove. Motion carried unanimously.

Next up Ms. Christine Sanders with the Belle Grove neighborhood watch addressed the jury in reference to the proposed senior housing development plans on North Grove. The jurors listened to the concerns of Ms. Sanders as well as other citizens of the Belle Grove subdivision and advised that no actions had been taken and that a public hearing is being set for September 25, 2023 and they can then come in and voice their concerns.

Jurors brought forward the following Ordinance Violations:

Mr. Whittington – 870 Airport Rd. needs a grass cutting letter.

A motion was made by Mr. Probst, duly seconded by Mr. Whittington, to cite the above violation. Motion carried unanimously.

Work Orders from the Jurors were next brought forward. A motion was made by Mr. Probst, duly seconded by Mrs. Allen to approve the following:

Mr. Bachus – Canal needs cutting on 10th and 15th street and limbs need to be picked up on Highway 568.

Mr. Whittington – Limbs need to be picked up on the south end of Eagle Rd.

Mrs. Allen – Grass needs to be cut down the sides of Smart Lane.

Mr. Neal – Limbs on Pecan Rd. on the right side.

Mr. Adams – dips on Boggy Bayou on both sides of the bridge.

The following updates were provided for Superintendent’s Work Orders:

610(yards) – 26 yds on Bob Rife, 7 yds on Haphazard, 270 yds on Doty Rd., 32yds on Boggy Bayou, 16yds on Pete Davis, and 80 yds on Robbert Webber.

Pitrun(yards) – 32yds on Ames and 32yds on Bodark

18”x32’ culvert on Passman Rd.

24”x36’ culvert on Passman Rd.

Under new business the following were brought forward:


