

**CONCORDIA PARISH POLICE JURY
REGULAR MEETING
November 10, 2025
6:00 P.M.**

The Concordia Parish Police Jury met this day in regular session convened. There were present the following members:

The meeting was called to order by President Lewis Ms. Carter conducted the roll and a Quorum was declared present.

Upon a motion by Mr. Probst, duly seconded by Mr. Edwards to approve the minutes from the October 27, 2025 regular meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mrs. Allen, duly seconded by Mr. Davis to approve the absence of Mr. Red Tiffie from the October 27, 2025 regular meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Probst, duly seconded by Mr. Bachus to approve purchase orders, statutory reports, bank statements, and bank reconciliations as reported. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Probst, duly seconded by Mr. Simpson to enter a public hearing on adopting revised ordinances 21-7 (Filling drainage ditches or impeding drainage thereof by the operation of farm equipment prohibited), and 21-8 (Use of Parish roads as turnrows by farm tractors prohibited.) to raise the fines from \$100.00 to \$1,000.00 for the first offense and from \$500.00 to \$5,000.00 for the second offense. Motion carried unanimously.

During the public hearing Mr. Tiffie advised the jury that he doesn't think they can raise fines by a state statute and asked Mrs. Carter to follow up on this.

Upon a motion by Mr. Probst, duly seconded by Mrs. Allen to exit the public hearing. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mrs. Allen, duly seconded by Mr. Simpson to table adopting revised ordinances 21-7 (Filling drainage ditches or impeding drainage thereof by the operation of farm equipment prohibited), and 21-8 (Use of Parish roads as turnrows by farm tractors prohibited.) to raise the fines from \$100.00 to \$1,000.00 for the first offense and from \$500.00 to \$5,000.00 for the second offense. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Probst, duly seconded by Mr. Edwards to approve to advertise for a public hearing on adopting an ordinance on the merging of voting precincts 1-1 and 1-2.

Upon a motion by Mr. Edwards, duly seconded by Mr. Davis to approve to assist with the Village of Clayton with the maintenance of the grass and vegetation surrounding the municipal lagoon area. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Tiffie, duly seconded by Mr. Probst to approve an occupational license and alcohol beverage permit for The Landing & RV Park in Monterey. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Edwards, duly seconded by Mr. Davis to approve having the maintenance unit serviced for mold in the amount of \$4,045.00. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Probst, duly seconded by Mr. Davis to cite the following ordinance violations. Motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Bachus – End of Railroad Drive is being turned into a dumping site; between 153 and 159 Skipper Drive has debris on property; 353 Skipper Drive and behind it has trash and overgrown; Between 318 & 387 has an abandoned trailer and garbage beside 179 Skipper Drive.

Mr. Simpson – Will verify but 168 Concordia Park Drive has a trailer parked on side of the road that needs to be moved.

Work Orders from the Jurors were next brought forward. A motion was made by Mrs. Allen, duly seconded by Mr. Bachus, to approve the following:

Mr. Washington – Tillman Road needs potholes filled.

Mr. Probst – Old Shields house near BASF needs debris picked up by boom truck.

Mrs. Allen – lights need to be placed on Black Bayou and Kentucky.

Mr. Edwards – Dead trees on the side of Pete Davis Road need to be looked at to see if they are on the parish ROW.
Mr. Tiffie – check Phillip’s Field Road for potholes.

The following updates were provided for Superintendent’s Work Orders:
610 (yards) 30yds on Eagle, 15yds on Stephens, 15yds on Archer, 30yds on Williams, 15 Bogy Bayou and 45 yds on Ploudin Bayou.

New Business:

Upon a motion by Mrs. Allen, duly seconded by Mr. Bachus to email Entergy to inquire about the lighting on Doty Road. Motion carried unanimously.


Upon a motion by Mr. Edwards, duly seconded by Mr. Probst to advertise for sealed bids to have the counter tops in the Clerk’s office renovated. Motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Lewis advised jurors that the new Asphalt Zipper would be delivered on 11/11/2025.

Upon a motion by Mrs. Allen, duly seconded by Mr. Edwards to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.
