REGULAR MEETING  
November 28, 2016

The Police Jury of Concordia Parish met this day in regular session convened. There were present the following members:

A motion was made by Mr. Wilkinson seconded by Mr. Parker to approve the minutes of the regular meeting of November 14, 2016 as mailed. Motion carried.

Mr. Shirley gave a brief report from the finance committee saying that the 2017 proposed budget had been distributed to all jurors. Mr. Friloux reported that the budget was complete but monies for the parish drainage study will be added in the final proposed budget at the December meeting. All line items will be adjusted to reflect income and expenses through the first week in December. The report was accepted as presented.

A motion was made by Mr. Parker seconded by Mr. Shirley to approve the renewal of the Blue Cross/Blue Shield Health Plan for 2017 with an increase of premiums at the rate of 3½ %. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. Shirley seconded by Mr. Beatty to approve the 2017 police jury regular meeting schedule as presented. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. Beatty seconded by Mr. Tiffie to authorize the secretary to work with the health unit for hiring a part-time clerk's position. Mr. Parker then added that he had received additional information in this matter and he made a substitute motion to table the matter which was seconded by Mr. Tiffie. The substitute motion carried.

The bid on surplus furniture was opened. One bid was received from Mr. William Couie for \$150 for the brown ensemble desk. A motion was made by Mr. Cook seconded by Mr. Dunbar to turn the bid over to the courthouse committee for review. Motion carried.

The next item was to consider a recommendation to the Louisiana Supreme Court of an individual to fill the vacancy in the office of Justice of the Peace, District 2 due to the resignation of Kevin Friloux. After a brief discussion a motion was made by Mr. Beatty seconded by Mr. Tiffée to make no recommendation. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. Parker seconded by Mr. Dunbar to notify Entergy of a damaged power pole on Leroy Williams Road. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. Tiffée seconded by Mr. Beatty to approve Superintendent's Material & Work Request as follows: 28 yards of washed gravel for Bee Brake, 14 yards of washed gravel for Ames Road, 14 yards of washed gravel for Vernon Road and 28 yards of washed gravel for Temple Road. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. Parker seconded by Mr. Tiffée to lift the parish burn ban. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. Parker seconded by Mr. Dunbar to have the secretary treasurer to look into the feasibility of and procedure for hiring of an assistant emergency preparedness director. Motion carried.

There being no further business a motion was made by Mr. Dunbar seconded by Mr. Wilkinson that the meeting be adjourned. Motion carried.
