Upon a motion by Mr. Probst, duly seconded by Mr. Adams to approve the minutes of the September 12, 2022 regular meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Joseph Parker, Sr., duly seconded by Mr. Probst to enter a public hearing to set the speed limit on Sportsman's Lane. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Joseph Parker, Sr., duly seconded by Mr. Neal to set the speed limit on Sportsman's Lane to 15 miles per hour. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Parker, duly seconded by Mrs. Allen to close the public hearing notice. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Probst, duly seconded by Mrs. Allen to approve a Resolution 22-021 authorizing the President to sign any and all Titles and Bill of Sales for sold surplus property. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Probst, duly seconded by Mrs. Allen to approve a Resolution 22-022 and 22-023 authorizing Ariella Carter to sign checks and handle any and all transactions pertaining to the Jury's accounts. Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Mr. Parker, duly seconded by Mr. Probst to send a letter of support to the Concordia Parish Sheriff's Office letting them know that the Jury is in support of the opposing the Go-Ye Ministries. Motion carried unanimously.
