

**CONCORDIA PARISH POLICE JURY
SPECIAL MEETING
NOVEMBER 7, 2017
4:00 P.M.**

The Police Jury of Concordia Parish met this day in regular session convened. There were present the following members:

A special meeting of the Concordia Parish Police Jury was conducted on November 7, 2017 to open and read into record proposals for Solid Waste services. Four proposals were received by the deadline of noon on November 3, 2017. These were Waste Management, Waste Pro, Pelican Waste & Debris LLC, and Metro Service Group Inc.

The proposals were read into record as follows accounting for servicing 4,500 households in the Parish:

Service Alternate 001- House to House Collection and Disposal of Residential Solid Waste

Service Alternate 001-1 – Contractor Operation of two Parish Compactor sites to include 12 annual disposals of the compactor and 24 disposals of the open top containers for each site. The pricing requested is for costs above the amount of disposals listed above.

Service Alternate 002 – Collection and Disposal of residential White Goods and Bulk Items. This service alternate was optional to submit from the Contractors. The Contractors if bidding, were asked to bid on 1) monthly lump sum price per ton on an as needed basis and 2) monthly lump sum price per ton on a designated date(s) of each month.

Waste Management

Alternative 001 - A proposed monthly rate of \$64,665 or \$14.37 per household; \$14.37 per unit price above 4,500 households. Pricing exceptions were noted in an addendum to be reviewed by the Jury's Committee.

Alternative 001-1 – A proposed collection fee of \$480 per open lid container and \$400 per compactor

Alternative 002 – Alternate Bid pricing as listed in the addendum allowing for 2 cubic yard limit per resident per collection day. A proposed price of \$1.90 per unit per month for every other week bulky waste collection.

Location of Landfill to be used – Plantation Oaks Landfill, Sibley, MS

Waste Pro

Alternative 001 – A proposed monthly rate of \$60,975 or \$13.55 per household; \$0.00 per unit price above 4,500 households.

Alternative 001-1 – A proposed collection fee of \$345 per open lid container and \$345 per compactor

Alternative 002 – No bid

Location of Landfill to be used – Tensas Parish Landfill

Pelican Waste & Debris LLC

Alternative 001 – A proposed monthly rate of \$73,890 or \$16.42 per household; \$16.25 per unit price above 4,500 households

Alternative 001-1 – A proposed collection fee of \$300 per open lid container per haul plus disposal and \$350 per compactor with a proposed collection fee of \$425 per month on compactor rental

Alternative 002 – No bid

Location of Landfill to be used – Tensas Parish Landfill

Metro Service Group Inc

Alternative 001 – A proposed monthly rate of \$67,257 or \$14.95 per household; \$0.00 per unit price above 4,500 households.

Alternative 001-1 – A proposed collection fee of \$235 per open lid container and \$325 per compactor

Alternative 002 – A proposed monthly lump sum price of \$350 per ton on an as need basis and a proposed rate of \$300 per ton on a designated date(s) of each month

Location of Landfill to be used – Riverbend Landfill, Fayette, MS

A motion was made by Mr. Parker seconded by Mr. Jernigan to table the decision to the Solid Waste and Finance Committee to review and prepare for awarding the winner at the November 13, 2017 regular meeting. Motion carried.

There being no further business, a motion was made by Mr. Parker seconded by Mr. Tiffie to adjourn. Motion carried.
